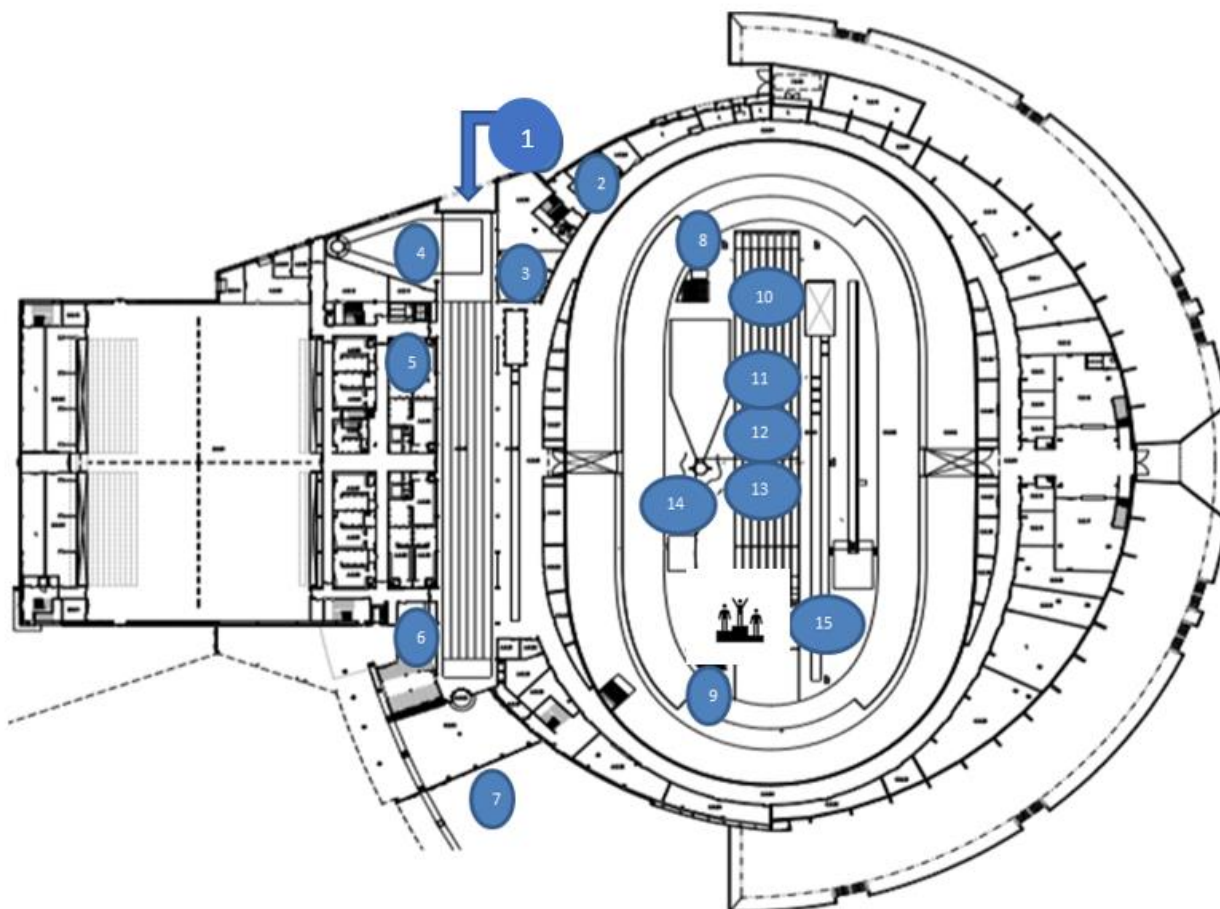

- After dark you will require a front and back light fitted to your bike.
- Ensure you adhere to all road signs and do not ride on the footway, this is illegal and may result in a fine.
- Please make sure you have your ID with you when you are outside the venue.

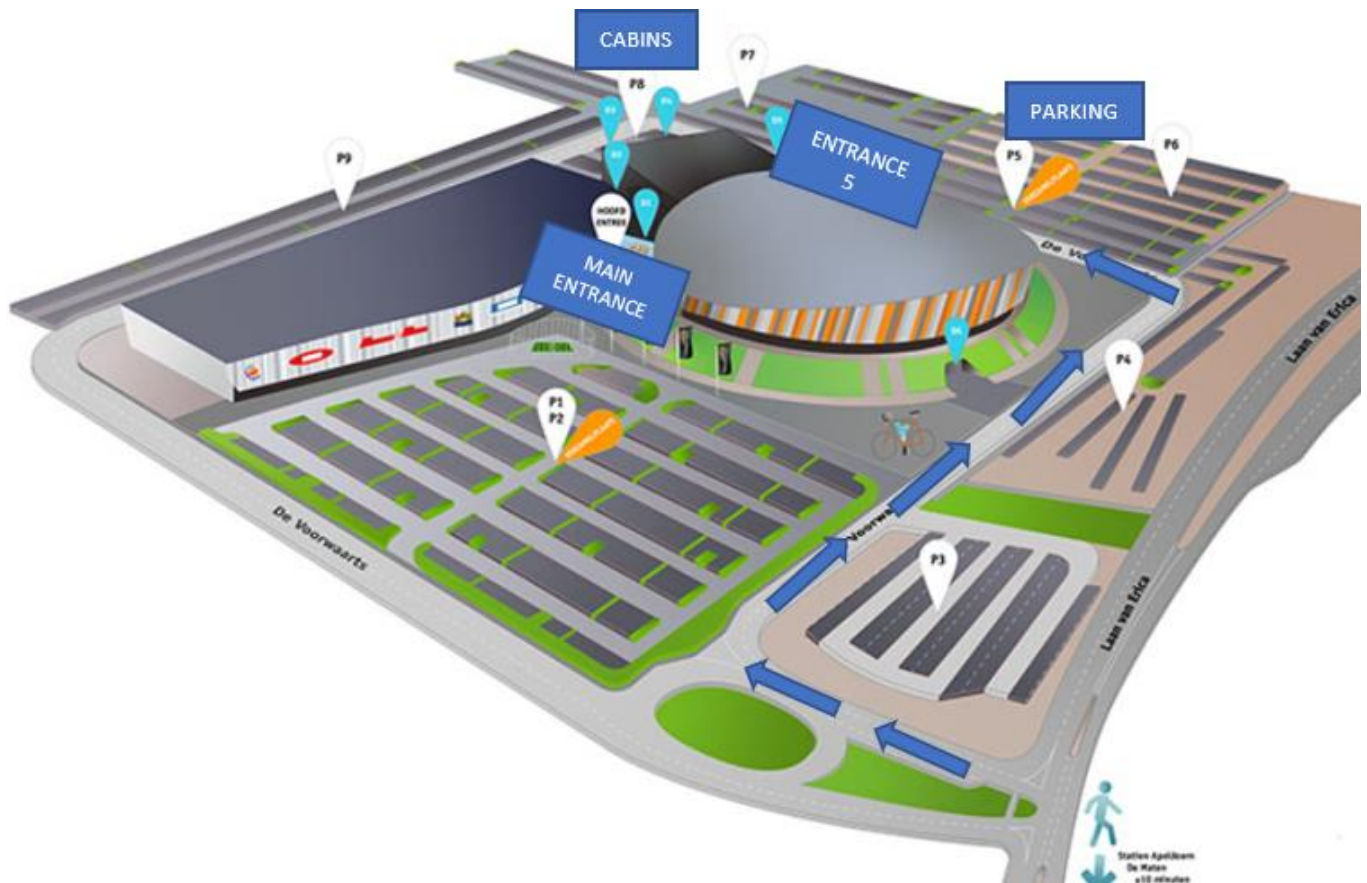
Teams and accredited media must use the designated parking space near the container village to ensure efficient parking arrangements.

The reserved parking lots P5/P6 can be easily located by following the signs labeled "Teams."

Upon arrival, teams and media can access Entrance 5 and collect their accreditation.

Please remember that the parking area (P5/P6), entrance 5, and the container village (P8) are located behind the building.

As you arrive at the venue, kindly proceed to the other side of the Velodrome, as illustrated in the image below, for easy access.



3. GENERAL INFORMATION

3.1. ACCREDITATION

Accreditations can be collected starting from Monday, 8 January, at the accreditation centre located on the ground floor of the Velodrome during opening hours. (See map on page 7, number 4)

Please ensure that you collect your accreditation as soon as you arrive at Omnisport as it will be required to access to all parts of the venue.

Accreditations must be worn and visible whenever you pass through accreditation controls.

3.4. TEAM MANAGERS MEETING

Team managers can take the lift or stairs from the main entrance and follow directional signage towards the Business Lounge.

3.5. TEAMS STORAGE AREA

Teams will be allocated storage containers based on the number of riders they have entered. The containers in car park 8 (cabins), as indicated on page 10 of the map, are equipped with lighting. Security personnel will be present 24/7 in the team cabin area starting Saturday, January 6th. If teams arrive before the event, they should contact a.haantjes@libemaproficycling.nl.

Teams can access the storage compound from **13:00 on Saturday, January 6th, until 20:00 on Sunday, January 14th**. The Team Cabin Coordinator will meet each team upon arrival and lead them to their designated cabin. It is crucial that teams only use the cabin assigned to them, as some smaller teams may have to share cabins due to space constraints and the number of teams entered.

A security deposit of €100 in cash per key is required. Teams must sign their key back in by **10:00 on Monday, January 15th, at the latest**.

Lost or unreturned keys will result in a charge of €100 per key. The deposit will be refunded once the team cabin has been inspected and left in the same condition as when it was issued. If the team cabin sustains any damage, the deposit will not be refunded, and additional repair costs may be incurred.

A replacement key is available from the Team Cabin Coordinator if a key is lost. Teams are responsible for replacing lost keys, which is €100 per key.

3.6. TEAM BOXES (infield)

Infield boxes will be available from **Sunday, 7 January**. The Velodrome will be open from **09:00 until 19:00**. Team boxes are allocated in the infield, considering the size of each team. Due to the large number of people in the track center, the space is limited, and we ask you to keep to your allocated area.

Fire Regulations insist that corridors in the track are maintained for emergency evacuation purposes. To ensure the track center can be cleared quickly and safely in an emergency, please ensure that equipment does not excessively narrow or block walkways. Team boxes will have one table and enough chairs. No furniture is to be removed from the allocated box or chained up.

Power supply in team boxes

Teams boxes will be powered with 230V, standard 2-pin outlet. The venue requires that all electrical equipment meets Dutch Standards to meet safety requirements. Teams must have all appliances tested and tagged by a qualified electrician. Please do not plug extension leads into this socket or kettles, coffee machines, or fan heaters, as they use high power consumption and may cause the supply to fail.

3.7. TEAMS CHANGING ROOMS

There are male and female changing rooms and shower facilities available at the ground level. See page 5, number 5.

3.8. TEAM PERFORMANCE ANALYSTS

An area for Performance Analysts will be provided. Availability is limited. Teams wishing to use this facility must **book** their position **until** December 13th.

Please note: bookings will be made on a first-come, first-served basis. We will provide WLAN Access to all positions. Performance Analysts cannot set up their own wireless networks as they interfere with other equipment in use. All "unofficial" wireless networks will be immediately uninstalled.

6.1. ARTICLE 1 - GENERAL RULES

- 1.1** The Union Européenne de Cyclisme in cooperation with Libema Profcycling will organise the 2024 Track Elite European Championships for the following disciplines.

These Championships may be contested by riders entered by their National Federation as a National Team.

- 1.2 Registrations must be submitted by the National Federations as follows:**

Registrations will be closing on the 29 December 2023, 23:59 CET

Entrants for European Championships shall hold licenses issued by a Federation affiliated to the UEC and have the nationality of the Federation doing the entry.

- 1.3** As the European Championships will be conducted in accordance with the UCI Regulations and format of the UCI World Championships, UCI article 9.2.022 is applied.

Team Managers may forward modifications to the Secretary of College of Commissaires until the start of the first competition session on the day of each event.

Therefore, National Federations may nominate the following riders / teams for the events:

Where the number of entries for an event exceeds the track limit, qualification heats will run according to the competition schedule.

- 1.4** In accordance with the UCI, the participation in the competitions shall be open to riders of the following categories: second-year junior, U23 and elite.
- 1.5** The riders to contest each Championship shall be confirmed by an official of their Federation, to the Commissaires, during the confirmation procedure, before the start of the Team Managers meeting.
- 1.6** Riders age shall be calculated as defined by the UCI rules.
- 1.7** **Body numbers – Clothes**
The riders are obliged to use the body numbers which will be supplied by the organisation. Body numbers may not be folded or altered.
Riders must compete in their national jersey.

Riders shall wear one (1) body number in the following events:

- 1km. TT and 500m. TT, Individual Pursuit, Team Pursuit (each rider one number), Team Sprint (each rider one number).

Riders shall wear two (2) body numbers in all other races, Omnium included.

Riders competing in Madison will receive dedicated body numbers.

Pin less number systems

Bunch events : numbers must be placed on outer layer of clothing

Individual Pursuit / TT Km and 500m / Team Pursuit / Team Sprint : number pockets permitted

1.8 **Publication**

All results, rankings and communiqués will be available in teams announcement boards.
Results will also be published on the UEC website: www.uec.ch and on the official live timing website: www.tissotiming.com

1.9 Unforeseen

In those events in which the regulations do not specify, the commissaires panel, in conjunction with the UEC Technical Delegate and the organisation (where applicable), will decide.

- 1.10 As per UCI regulation 1.3.023, any rider of height 1.80m and taller, who wishes to apply for height exemption for handlebar extensions, must submit a "Rider Attestation Application" form to the UCI 15 days prior the competition, so as to appear on the "UCI Official List of Riders in Category 2 & 3 Height" document. No rider height measurements will be performed at the championships.

6.2. ARTICLE 2 - EVENTS REGULATIONS

2.1. Sprint, Individual Pursuit, 1km and 500 m. Time Trials, Points Races, Keirin, Scratch Race, Team Pursuit, Team Sprint, Omnium, Madison.

All the above-mentioned Championships will be conducted in accordance with the UCI Regulations and format of the UCI World Championships.

- 2.2 The seeding for all the above-mentioned championships will be done according to the UCI Regulations article 3.2.021 bis. The current UCI World Champions and the former UEC European Champions of the discipline, can be seeded in the first position.

2.3 Elimination race (as a Championship)

For the start of the race, riders shall line-up in single file along the railing and in the sprinters lane.

The coaches holding their rider in the sprinters' lane are allowed to push them during the start but from a standstill position (2 feet on the ground at the same time).

The order of the riders shall be determined according to the UCI regulations, in respect to the current UCI Elimination Ranking by Nations.

The order for non-ranked nations, will be done by drawing lots during the Team Managers' meeting as follows:

- 1st draw – teams present at the Team Managers' meeting
- 2nd draw – teams not present at the Team Managers' meeting

6.3. ARTICLE 3 - AWARDS

Jersey and medals

Every European Championship will be awarded for:

The 1st place: Champion(s) jersey and Gold medal

The 2nd place: Silver medal

The 3rd place: Bronze medal

Winners are obliged to be in time for the awards ceremony.

Riders must present themselves in race clothing, wearing their national jersey and shall not wear a helmet, a cap a headband or glasses until they leave the podium ceremony area.

The anti-doping controls will be under the responsibility of the International Testing Agency (ITA).

6.5. ARTICLE 5 - PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

6.6. ARTICLE 6 – RESPONSABILITIES

The organizers and UEC will not, under any circumstances, be liable to any accidents or damage that occurs during training and competitions.

The organizers and UEC decline all responsibilities towards the riders and others in case of an accident.

For all cases not covered by these specific regulations, the UCI rules will apply. Any problems will be solved between the organizers, the Commissaires Panel and UEC officials.
