PARTICIPATION

Categories: Men / Women Elite 20"
Men Elite 26"
Men / Women Juniors 20"
Men Juniors 26"

Every nation may register maximum of 5 riders per category.

Riders must compete in their national jersey.

The UCI World Champion in each category has to ride with his UCI World Champion Jersey.

Opening of the Women Junior category at the 2024 UEC Trials European Championships:

- The Junior Women category is open to young women aged 15/16/17/18 →U19.

Special case 1:

Junior Women in 2024 who took part in the final of the 2023 UEC Trials European Championships remain in the Elite Women category. They may not compete in the Junior Women category in 2024 or in subsequent years.

Special case 2:

Junior Women who are in the TOP 10 of the UCI Trials ranking by 17 September 2024, after the UCI Trials World Cup held in Cordon may choose to compete in the Junior or Elite category. From 2024 onwards, the Junior category will be that of the UCI with no possibility of choice as is the case for the Junior Men.

NB: Women riders taking part in the Women Junior category will be awarded with the same points as per Men Junior as per the point scale at the Continental Championships indicated at art 7.6.006 of the UCI regulations.

IDENTIFICATION FOR ATHLETES AND MINDERS

All athletes and minders will be identified by bracelet with different colours for the categories. Entering sections is allowed for bracelet owners only.

AWARDS CEREMONIES, AWARDS AND PRIZE MONEY

AWARDS CEREMONY

In accordance with articles 1.2.112 and 1.2.113 of the UCI Regulations, the 3 best riders of each category must attend the official awards ceremony. Unless otherwise stated, riders shall appear at official ceremonies wearing competition clothing.

Riders must present themselves at the podium.

AWARDS

Jersey and medals

Every European Championship will be awarded with:

- 1st place: champion jersey and gold medal
- 2nd place: silver medal
- 3rd place: bronze medal

ANTIDOPING, PENALTIES, RESPONSIBILITIES

ANTIDOPING

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event.

The antidoping controls will be conducted under the responsibility of the ITA (International Testing Agency).

PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The organizers and UEC will not, under any circumstances, be liable to any accidents or damage that occurs during training and competitions.

The organizers and UEC decline all responsibilities towards the riders and others in case of an accident.

For all cases not covered by these specific regulations, the UCI rules will apply. Any problems will be solved between the organizers, the Commissaires Panel and UEC officials.
