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


What is CAREC?



Rebooting the Quadrilateral Traffic in Transit Agreement (QTTA) between PRC, PAK, KAZ and KGZ



- Successful Consultation Workshop in Bangkok, June 2015
- Agreement to take further action on corridor infrastructure, border crossing procedures, marketing/ awareness raising, harmonization of vehicle standards, etc.
- 2nd Consultation Workshop in Urumqi, 7-9 Sept 2015 to resolve outstanding issues
- Aim to maximize use of QTTA starting in 2016




