

# Times Higher Education (THE) World University Rankings 2024

## OVERVIEW OF RESULTS

The Times Higher Education World University Rankings is one of the most influential global rankings, published by the magazine Times Higher Education, for post-secondary institutions that consider the overall teaching, research, and international outlook of institutions. York University has increased in rank to the 351-400 band.

Underlying numbers suggest that York has made positive progress towards the top end of this band. Domestically, York is now tied at 15th place in Canada. The 2024 edition had 1,904 universities participate in the rankings. An overview of the rankings can be found in Table 1.

In terms of subject performance, York University has witnessed improvements in 2024 across a range of disciplines, including Clinical and Pre-clinical Health, Education, Engineering, Law, and Social Sciences. There is continued downward momentum for Business & Economics and Computer Science subjects.
