INTRODUCTION

What are the Field Debriefing Forms? In this TAPEC activity, regional supervisors will be responsible for collecting feedback from their field supervisors to share at the NSO-wide post-pilot meeting. The following forms provide guidance for consolidating feedback from field enumerators and supervisors. Two debriefings should occur to assist regional supervisors in soliciting feedback.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FIELD DEBRIEFING

1. At the end of the pilot, each enumerator fills out a **Field Enumerator Debriefing Form**. This form will help enumerators evaluate their pilot fieldwork experience prior to the field debriefing.

2. Field supervisors meet with their team of enumerators at the field debriefing.

3. Field supervisors use the **Field Supervisor Debriefing Form** to guide the field debriefing discussion and complete the form with their teams' feedback and their own observations.

4. Field supervisors submit the **Field Supervisor Debriefing Form** responses to their regional supervisor and discuss issues at the regional debriefing.

5. Regional supervisors compile responses and prepare to share feedback at the NSO-wide post-pilot meeting.

Note: It is important that field debriefings should be conducted separately at the team and regional levels, if these levels exist during the pilot. The questions listed in this form are intended as guidelines and may not be comprehensive for all issues that are discussed. When conducting a debriefing, it is important to make sure everyone has a chance to speak.
